28 Mayor Wilkinson read aloud a determination regarding
29 electronic meetings without an anchor location due to
30 COVID-19

31 **WORK SESSION WITH LEGISLATORS**

33 Senate President Stuart Adams spoke of difficulties related to the COVID-19 pandemic
34 and expressed hope for a bright 2021. He shared the opinion that the market would do more to
35 help the current housing situation than government housing programs. Senator Todd Weiler
36 spoke of the many bills related to public safety prepared for the upcoming Legislative Session.
37 Mayor Wilkinson thanked the Senators for meeting with the Council.

39 Representative Tim Hawkes commented that accessory dwelling units (ADUs) would be
40 discussed during the upcoming Legislative Session, and said he was aware of many bills
41 drafted to address public safety issues. Police Chief Paul Child shared concerns regarding bills
42 related to concealed carry regulations and use-of-force/qualified immunity situations.
43 Representative Hawkes spoke of bills on which he had been working. The Council and
44 Representative Hawkes discussed distribution of COVID-19 vaccinations. The Mayor and
45 Council thanked Representative Hawkes for his time.

50 McEwan seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote (5-0).


