27 Mayor Wilkinson read aloud a determination regarding
28 *electronic meetings without an anchor location due to*
29 COVID-19

30 **SOUTH DAVIS PARAMEDICS SERVICES TRANSFER**

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32 City Manager Brant Hanson explained that several entities had expressed a desire to
33 individually take over paramedic services from the County, and the County was willing to transfer
34 the responsibility. He stated Centerville would not be largely impacted because of the paramedic
35 services available through South Davis Metro Fire District. Fire Chief Dan Stone expressed
36 support for the change, and confirmed that paramedic service to Centerville would continue and
37 possibly improve. He said the plan was for the County to continue providing paramedic services
38 until 2023, as other entities prepared to take on the responsibility.
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40 **ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN-UP**

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42 Cameron Woodbury, Public Works Drainage Utility Operator, suggested three options
43 were available for the City's annual spring clean-up: cancel the event because of the current
44 pandemic; send citizens to the Bountiful Landfill with their green waste and cover the cost as a
45 City; or host green waste collection at a City park. He said the Staff recommendation was to
46 provide a green waste dumpsite at the west end of Community Park. Councilmember Ince
47 commented that the annual spring clean-up was not as convenient as it used to be when green
48 waste could be placed in the curb. He asked if it would be possible to place 20-30 dumpsters
49 throughout the City to allow people to dispose of green waste closer to their homes, with
50 individuals in each dumpster area tasked with the responsibility of monitoring what was placed in


1 the dumpsters. Councilmember Ince said he knew there were complications with his suggestion,
2 but he pointed out there were many individuals without vehicles capable of transporting large
3 amounts of green waste.
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5 Mr. Hanson suggested the Council make a decision on how to proceed in 2021, and direct
6 Staff to research other options for the 2022 clean-up. Mr. Woodbury commented that Bountiful
7 City provided curb-side pickup, but required all materials to be bagged and placed behind the
8 sidewalk to avoid storm drain contamination. Councilmember Ince said he was willing to accept
9 Mr. Hanson's suggestion, with a green waste dumpsite at Community Park in 2021.
10 Councilmembers Ince and Mecham said they did not see the garbage bag option working for
11 green waste. *Administrative Services Director Jacob Smith explained the cost of dumpsters, and*
12 *spoke of complications with potential mixed waste types.*
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14 A majority of the Council indicated agreement with providing a green waste dumpsite at
15 Community Park for spring clean-up in 2021, and directing Staff to research options for 2022. The
16 Council discussed hours the dumpsite would be open, and suggested 9:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. on
17 the two Saturdays selected, and 4:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. on the Monday through Friday in between.

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21 At 6:17 p.m., Councilmember Ince **moved** to adjourn the work session. Councilmember
22 Ivie seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote (4-0).
